THINGS TO REMEMBER FOR 2025 REGISTRATION PROCESS:

1. Registration:

All registration for the 2024 Science Fair will be done on the internet following the registration process detailed on the Lambton County Science Fair website www.lambtoncountysciencefair.ca.

Deadline for Registration: Monday, March 24th, 2025 at 5:00pm

Online registration will be cut off at 5:00 pm on this date. Anyone wishing to register after this date must contact Ashley Murray by e-mail at Ashley.Murray@lkdsb.net

2. Required Forms for Registration:

3. Registration Fee

A fee of \$5 for each student (e.g. \$10 for project working in partnership) is ***payable at the registration table on Friday, April 4, 2025***. This payment is non-refundable. Please bring cash or make cheques payable to "Lambton County Science Fair". **Please note this fee is only for students that are in grade 7-12.**

- **LOCATION:** Main gymnasium (D1-211) at Lambton College

 - Students will be greeted by a member of the Registration committee, given a name tag and told where to set up their exhibits.
 - ALL** Projects **MUST** be signed in **by 5 PM to be eligible for judging.**
- **JUDGING:**

Friday, April 4th:	6 pm to 9 pm
Saturday, April 5th:	9 am to 12 pm

Students are expected to remain with their projects Friday from 6 pm to 9:00 pm and Saturday from 9 am to 12 pm. There will be scheduled breaks during this time.
- **TAKE DOWN:**

Projects may be taken down after 12 pm on Saturday, April 5th.
- **AWARDS:**

The Awards ceremony starts at 1:00 p.m. Saturday in the Lambton College Ballroom.
